<b>Lettings Services</b>	
Letting only	12% of the agreed rent for the entire term due in full at the commencement of the tenancy
Letting & Property Management	18% of agreed rent 12% letting fee, of which is due in full at the commencement of the tenancy for the entire initial term, and 6% property management fee of which is due as the rent is collected.
Property Management Only (includes rent collection)	6% of the agreed rent for the entire term and any renewal / extension due as the rent is collected.
